



ACCOMMODATIONS

We have reserved rooms for the October Short Course at the Courtyard Marriott in Chapel Hill. The Courtyard has a breakfast café, local restaurant delivery, swimming pool, and other services. It is **directly across from the Friday Center**, where the training takes place, as well as 2 miles from downtown Chapel Hill and the UNC campus. Rooms are being held for our group for the rate of \$139 per night, single or double occupancy, until September 4, 2009.

FROM/TO THE AIRPORT

For airport shuttles, A Flat Rate Airport Shuttle (919-782-8738 or 919-493-8738) seems to be the cheapest, at around \$30 each way, \$5 per additional passenger. They require a call in advance to reserve. Most of the taxi services listed on the flier also offer airport shuttles.

Taxis generally cost \$30 to \$45 each way. See the taxi dispatch booths at the curb outside the baggage claim areas. Or use the enclosed flier with taxis and phone numbers listed.

Our group rate with Thrifty Car Rental starts at \$26.96 per day. See the enclosed flier.

TO THE COURSE

If you are driving, parking is plentiful at the Friday Center. Make sure to park in the lot designated for guests of the Friday Center. **Do not park in the student parking area – you will get a ticket.** Those at the Courtyard may simply walk across the street each morning, but there will be no shuttle service to hotels.

IN THE EVENINGS

Public buses do not run in the evenings, but local taxis do (see flier). There are a handful of good restaurants within walking distance of the Courtyard in Meadowmont, and many more in downtown Chapel Hill and the general area. If you already have to get yourself to and from the airport, and *especially* if you have a fellow traveler to share the expense, a rental car may be the best solution. (See Thrifty flier.)
